Heard Mr. Giri, learned senior counsel for the petitioners and
Mr. Romy Chacko, learned counsel appearing for the
respondent-caveator(s).

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we think it
appropriate that the petitioners should move the High Court in
review as one of the submissions is that the High Court has not
appreciated certain facts in an apposite manner. If an application
for review is filed within four weeks hence, we request the High
Court to deal with the same on merits within eight weeks therefrom.

The High Court is further requested to condone the delay and proceed with the matter on merits. We may further state that the factual aspect should be specifically addressed to by the High Court while passing the order in the application for review.

Be it made clear, in case the petitioners do not succeed in application for review, liberty is granted to challenge the main order as well as the order passed in the review application.

With the aforesaid observations and request, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of. There will be no order as to costs.
