O R D E R

Leave granted.

The present appeal arises from the order of the High Court remitting the case of the appellant to the Scheduled Tribe Certificate Scrutiny Committee, Aurangabad Region, for determination of the claimed status by the appellant as belonging to the "Koli Mahadev", scheduled tribe.

In the nature of the order we propose to pass, it is considered appropriate to take note of the facts only to the extent necessary. Suffice it to state that during an inquiry with regard to the caste status of the appellant for admission, his father's caste certificate also came to be cancelled. The father of the appellant has filed a separate petition, i.e., Writ Petition

No.11043/2018 (Bapu Manik Kore Vs. The State of Maharashtra & Ors.) before the High Court and which is stated to be pending.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the fact that the writ petition of the appellant's father is still pending, we consider it proper to set aside the impugned order of the High Court, restore the writ petition of the appellant and request the High Court to hear both the writ petitions together.

Needless to state that there is an urgency in the matter, concerning the admission of the appellant to the BAMS Course in the academic session 2019-2020, under the Scheduled Tribe category. We, therefore, grant liberty to the appellant to file an appropriate application before the High Court for priority hearing, including the seeking of interim orders so that the academic interests of the appellant are adequately safeguarded.

The appeal is allowed in the above terms. Pending applications shall stand disposed of.
