Leave granted.

In the course of hearing, a suggestion was given to Mrs. Kanchan K. Dhodi, learned counsel appearing for the appellant, taking into consideration the percentage of disability, whether the claim put forth will be satisfied if the award is enhanced by Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees five lacs only). Learned counsel immediately agreed to the said suggestion. Mrs. Pankaj Bala Varma, learned counsel appearing for the respondents, left it to the discretion of the Court.

Considering the nature of the injury, the amount awarded is enhanced by aggregate Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees five lacs only) with the stipulation that the same shall be deposited within twelve weeks hence, before the Tribunal, failing which it shall carry interest at the rate of 9% per annum from the date of application before the Tribunal. The amount deposited shall be disbursed in favour of the appellant on proper identification.

With the aforesaid modification in the award passed by the tribunal, which has been further modified by the High Court, the appeal stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
