Heard Ms. Siddhi Gupta, learned counsel appears for the petitioner. Also, Mr. V. Krishnamurthy, learned Sr. A.A.G. appears for the State of Tamil Nadu, Mr. K. Krishna Kumar, and Mr. Narendra Kumar appears for the respective respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although multiple settlement attempts were made, the matter has not been resolved between the parties. In the meantime, the complaint filed by the petitioner has remained without any final closure by the police for last several years.

Learned counsel appearing for the private respondents also make similar submission about the settlement not being successful.

Responding to the above, Mr. V. Krishnamurthy learned Sr. A.A.G. who appears for the State of Tamil Nadu submits that the police will conclude the investigation and take to its logical legal conclusion, without any further loss of time.

Noting the above submission, the State is granted three months time to conclude the investigation on the

complaint filed by the petitioner.
