O R D E R

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, learned senior counsel for the petitioners on instructions states that the appeal preferred by the petitioners before the Division Bench against the order of the learned Single Judge dated 12.07.2019 itself be treated as withdrawn.

We accept the request. The appeal of the petitioners before the Division Bench is thus dismissed as withdrawn and consequently any interim arrangement made thereof shall stand dissolved.

The interim arrangement as opined by the learned Single Judge in its order dated 12.07.2019 stands restored noticing that it is in the nature of peremptory order.

The Special Leave Petitions stand disposed of.

Pending applications stand disposed of.

Needless to say that the direction passed by the Division Bench in APO No.109/2019 would thus, prevail.
