O R D E R

Learned counsel for the parties submits that there is a chance for amicable settlement of the issue. Evidently, the couple has got two children aged 9 years and 6 years respectively. In the best interest of children, it is only befitting that the parties may be sent for mediation. In the said circumstances, the parties are directed to appear before the Supreme

Court Mediation Centre on 10.08.2022 at 11:00 AM.
