O R D E R

Learned counsel for the respondents has drawn the attention of the Court to the order passed by this Court on 23.05.2025, which reads as under:-

"In view of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners seeking time to file rejoinder affidavit to the counter affidavit, which we have been informed was served in the year 2022, we grant time and post the matter for 29.08.2025.

2. However, in the facts and circumstances of the present case, the stay granted on 05.01.2022 of the order impugned stands withdrawn.

3. The matter be listed on 29.08.2025.”

2. When the order was being dictated, time was sought by learned counsel for the petitioners. However, the same stands rejected.

3. It was contended by learned counsel for the respondents that initially on 05.01.2022, the Court had granted stay of the impugned order but on 23.05.2025, the Court had specifically withdrawn the stay granted on 05.01.2022 of the impugned order. It was further contended that the specific withdrawal of the stay granted, required the petitioners to comply with the impugned order, which has not been done.

4. In the tentative view of the Court, we agree with the submission of learned counsel for respondent no.1 (workman) as admittedly, the order impugned has not been implemented without there being any stay granted and rather the earlier stay granted having been specifically withdrawn.

5. Accordingly, let show-cause notice be issued against the petitioners, as to why, they may not be proceeded for committing contempt of the Court by such conduct.

6. They shall be personally present with their show-cause on 18.12.2025, when the matter be listed at the top of the Board.

7. We further clarify that if by that date, the contempt, as observed above is not purged, the Court will take a strict view in the matter.
