O R D E R

1. The instant appeal has been filed challenging the order dated 19.06.2023, passed by the Disciplinary Committee of the Bar Council of India. Vide the said order, the appellant-advocate has been debarred from practicing before any court of law, tribunal and quasi-judicial authority during the pendency of the trial.

2. When the matter came up for hearing before this Court on 23.08.2024, the following order was passed:

"1. Subject to the appellant depositing the cost of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty-five thousand) with the Supreme Court Advocates-on-Record Welfare Fund, let notice be issued to the respondent-Bar Council of India for the limited purpose as to why one opportunity of hearing be not accorded to the appellant for systematic reconsideration of the quantum of punishment, returnable on 25.10.2024.

2. Dasti, in addition, is permitted."

3. Learned counsel for the Bar Council of India fairly states that in the peculiar facts and circumstances of this case, a fresh opportunity of hearing will be accorded to the appellant. That being so, the impugned order dated 19.06.2023 is set aside and the appeal is allowed in part.

4. The Bar Counsel of India shall intimate the date, time, and venue to the appellant to appear before the Disciplinary Committee.

5. As a sequel to the above, the pending interlocutory application also stands disposed of.
