UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

The first anticipatory bail application was filed at the instance of the petitioner under Section 438 of Cr.P.C, which was withdrawn after the Court dilated the matter on merits by an Order dated 07th July, 2021. Thereafter the petitioner filed second anticipatory bail application which he withdrew on 12th November, 2021. The successive third anticipatory bail application filed at the instance of the petitioner came to be dismissed under the order impugned dated 24th November, 2021.

We find no change in circumstances which prevailed upon the petitioner of filing the third successive anticipatory bail application which came to be dismissed under the order impugned dated 24th November, 2021. We deprecate such practice of filing successive anticipatory bail applications under Section 438 of Cr.P.C.

We have heard counsel for the petitioner and we find no reason to interfere in the Special Leave Petition. The petition is accordingly dismissed.
