O R D E R

This is not a case for quashing of the charge-sheet and to that extent the order of the High Court does not call for any interference. At the same time, though the FIR was registered for the offences punishable under Sections 376, 377, 323, 504, 342, 498-A and 313 of the IPC, the charge-sheet has, ultimately, been filed only under Sections 498-A and 506 of the IPC.

In view thereof, we direct the petitioners to surrender within a period of three weeks and thereafter move an application for regular bail, which can be considered favourably, keeping in view the aforesaid aspects.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners are ready to explore the possibility of settlement of dispute through mediation. Such request can also be made to the trial court which can refer the parties to mediation.

The special leave petition is dismissed.
