O R D E R

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned counsel for the respondent, in the facts and circumstances
of the instant case since sufficient time has elapsed after the
order was passed by the High Court appointing the learned
Arbitrator, at this stage, we see no reason to interfere with the
impugned order.

However, all contentions are left open to be urged before
the learned Arbitrator.

Insofar as the procedure, we make it clear that the arbitration proceedings before the learned Arbitrator appointed by the High Court will not be bound by any of the procedure laid down in the rules governing the Karnataka Arbitration Centre. It would be independently dealt with by the learned Arbitrator adopting the procedure under Singapore International Arbitration Centre (SIAC) Rules.

Accordingly, the special leave petition is disposed of.
