O R D E R

We have heard petitioner-in-person as he claimed that he was not able to connect due to some connectivity technical problem.

The fact remains that it is next to impossible to decipher from the application what is sought to be claimed. From the oral submissions made in Hindi it appears that the petitioner-in-person is troubled by the fact that the local pond has been dealt with improperly, some directions have been issued by NGT, the matter is pending before the High Court, some rights have been created over the pond and there is water problem. On our query, petitioner-in-person states that he is not a party in any of the proceedings.

It appears that the petitioner-in-person is a troubled soul on the issue of water pond and if he is so concerned, he will have to move the requisite authorities for putting forth his point of view.

It can hardly be a cause to be entertained under Article 32 of the Constitution of India.

Miscellaneous application stands dismissed with the aforesaid liberty.
