**O R D E R**

Mr. D.N. Ray, being assisted by Mrs. Sumita Ray, entered Caveat.

Mr. D.N. Ray, learned counsel for the respondent submits that the application seeking visitation rights filed by the husband/caveator is already heard and the orders are reserved on the application to be pronounced on 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2020. His apprehension is that the transfer petition is filed only to delay the said proceedings and to see that the respondent/caveator does not get visitation rights.

The said submissions are opposed by Mr. Subodh Markandeya, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner.

We make it clear that if the application seeking visitation rights filed by the husband/caveator is already heard, the order will be pronounced by the Family Court in accordance with law on 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2020.

However, after hearing the parties at length, we feel it

appropriate to transfer the Family Suit No (F.S.) Nos.1932/2017 titled as Sharad Verma vs. Madhuri Sharad Verma, Family Suit (F.S.) No. 435 of 2018 titled as Madhuri Sharad Verma vs. Sharad Verma, Family Suit Nos.1603 and 1960 of 2018 titled as Sharad Anand Verma vs. Madhuri Sharad Verma from the Family Court, Ahmedabad, Gujarat to the Family Court of Jaipur, Rajasthan as prayed for by the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. However we make it clear that such transfer order shall come into effect only after the pronouncement of the order deciding visitation rights.

The transfer petitions are, accordingly, allowed.
