Writ Petition(C) No.267 of 2021 & Writ Petition(C) No.272/2021

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this Court by an Order dated 09th December, 2020 in Transfer Petition (C) No.2849-2859 of 2019 has transferred the Writ Petition from different High Courts which raises the issue regarding validity of Chapter VI of Guideline No.1-CA(7)/02/2008 dated 8th August, 2008. He submits that

in the Writ Petition petitioner is also raising the same issue.
