Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

This transfer petition has been filed seeking transfer of the T.S. (D) 39/2019 titled as " Aatish Agarwal Vs. Ruchi Agarwal " pending before the Court of District Judge at Dibrugarh, Assam, to the Court of Additional District and Sessions Judge, First Court, Siliguri, District; Darjeeling, West Bengal.

Vide Order dated 12.06.2020, the dispute between the parties was referred to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre.

Learned Counsel for the parties state that they have settled their dispute outside the Court by way of private settlement and an application under Article 142 of the Constitution of India has also been filed seeking a prayer to quash all the pending proceedings between the parties. The details whereof have been mentioned in paragraphs 3 and 4 of the joint application.

In view of the settlement arrived at between the parties, the proceedings in both the divorce as well as criminal proceedings initiated by the parties referred to in paragraphs 3 and 4 of the joint application stand quashed. It has also been stated in paragraph 8 that in compliance of the terms of the agreement, the

parties are living together happily and do not wish to continue any legal proceedings against each other. The parties shall abide by the terms of the settlement arrived at between them in the joint application.

With the aforesaid directions, the transfer petition stands finally disposed of.
