As per the Action Taken Report filed by Union of India, 88 occupants have since vacated the Government accommodation, whereas

two occupants were directed to vacate the premises, one on 18.04.2022 and another one on 31.05.2022. In respect of the third occupant, appropriate action is being taken for vacation of the Government accommodation.

Let Union of India take appropriate action, including eviction under the Public Premises (Eviction of Unauthorised Occupants) Act, 1971.

No further orders are called for in the present matter.
