**O R D E R**

This petition has been filed by the petitioner (wife) under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 seeking transfer of F.C.O.P. No.89/2019 titled as *Kodamala Ajesh Kumar vs. Bandaari Dhanalakhmi @ Kavya* pending before the Family Court, Anantapur, Andhra Pradesh to the Family Court Ballari, Karnataka.

Heard Mr. Ankolekar Gurudatta, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. Mithun Shashank, learned counsel appearing for the respondent (husband)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an orphan and is dependent on her uncle. She is residing at her uncle's house at Ballari. It is also submitted that the Maintenance case and a case filed under the Domestic Violence Act is pending in Ballari courts against the respondent where he is required to appear.

Mr. Mithun Shashank, learned counsel appearing for the respondent, however, submits that the proceedings at Ballari have

been initiated by the wife as a counter blast to the divorce proceedings filed by the husband in Anantpur court in Andhra Pradesh. It is also submitted that the respondent has lost his job and is apprehending threat from the petitioner's side, if he proceeds to Ballari.

Having considered the above submissions and weighing the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it fit and proper to allow the transfer petition. Accordingly, the F.C.O.P. No.89/2019 titled as *Kodamala Ajesh Kumar vs. Bandaari DhanaLakhmi @ Kavya* pending before the Family Court, Anantapur, Andhra Pradesh is transferred to the Family Court, Ballari, Karnataka.

Let the records of the case be transferred to the concerned court without delay.

Consequently, the Transfer Petition is allowed.
