O R D E R

Heard learned counsel appearing for both the parties and perused the averments made in the instant petition.

The petitioner seeks transfer of HMA No.1051/2018 instituted under Section 13 (1) (i-a) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as '*Rahul Asthana Vs. Smt. Reshu*' pending before the Court of Shri Pitamber Dutt, Judge, Family Court, South-West, District, Dwarka Court, Delhi to the Family Court at District Court Dehradun, Uttrakhand.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner at present is pursuing her higher studies in the United States of America, which is not disputed by the respondent. It is also submitted on behalf of her that she cannot return to India at present due to outbreak of Covid-19 and no one at present in India can look after the said case.

Having considered the submissions made on behalf of the respective parties, I am satisfied that interest of justice would

not be prejudiced in the event the aforesaid proceedings continues in the Family Court, South-West, District, Dwarka Court, Delhi. In the event, the petitioner is unable to contest the proceedings in Delhi for the time being because of the ongoing pandemic situation, adjournment may be asked for before the said court with prayer for fixing the date of hearing sometime in the month of September, 2020 or subsequent thereto depending upon the position of the outbreak of the said disease prevailing at that point of time. If such a prayer is made, the Family Court, Dwarka shall adjourn the hearing of the case as per prayers of the parties to such date which the court may find suitable and thereafter resolve the dispute fixing the matter on day-to-day basis as far as practicable.

The Transfer petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
