UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

It appears that even before our interim order dated 13.1.2020, pursuant to the remand order of the High Court, some Reference Cases under Section 18 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 had already been decided on 17.10.2019 which was not brought to our attention.

We are informed that out of 391 Reference Cases, final orders have been passed in 307 cases. The interim order dated 13.1.2020 is, therefore, lifted and stands vacated with regard to these 307 claimants without prejudice to the rights of the petitioners in accordance with law. Insofar as remaining Reference Cases are concerned our Interim Order dated 13.1.2020 shall remain in force but shall stand automatically vacated the day the Reference Cases are decided under Section 18 of the Act. This again shall be without prejudice to the rights of the petitioners in accordance with law.

The Special Leave Petitions stand disposed in the aforesaid terms.
