O R D E R

1. We have heard Mr. Dhruv Mehta, learned senior counsel, appearing on behalf of the petitioner. The respondents/alleged contemnors are also represented before us through Mr. Arvind Datar and Mr. Sanjiv Sen, learned senior counsel.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents/alleged contemnors stated, that there were technical hitches in the non-execution of the registered sale deed. It was submitted on behalf of the respondents, that whilst the respondents will make all endeavours to execute the registered sale deed, in terms of the order of this Court dated 25th October, 2016, as expeditiously as possible, the respondents shall hand over vacant possession of the premises in question to the petitioner, during the course of the day, i.e., today itself.

3. In view of the above, we direct the respondents/ alleged contemnors to hand over peaceful possession of the property in question to the petitioner, during the course of the day. We also direct the respondents/alleged contemnors to execute the registered sale deed, in terms of the order passed by this Court on 25th October, 2016, on or before 31st May, 2017.

4. The instant contempt petition is disposed of in the above terms.

5. In case the sale deed is not registered by the respondents/alleged contemnors, within the time indicated hereinabove, it shall be open to the petitioner to move an application for reviving the contempt petition.
