We have heard learned senior counsel appearing for the appellant-Department and perused the material on record.

At the outset, learned senior counsel submitted that although there is a low tax effect involved in these appeals nevertheless the appeals have been maintained since they involve questions of policy and important questions of law relating to the import policy of Union of India.
