O R D E R

Having heard the learned Senior counsel appearing for the parties and carefully perusing the material available on record, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High Court of Judicature at Madras.

Learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioners has placed some material i.e., the Report submitted by the District Registrar (Administration) as well as by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Madurai District about the complaint made by Respondent No.1- complainant against the petitioners herein.

We are not inclined to go into the merits of the case. As per the direction of the High Court, the concerned Police has to investigate the matter. The petitioners are at liberty to place all the material before the Police at the time of investigation.

With the above observation, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.

Pending application filed in the matter also stands disposed of.

It is pertinent to note that the Petitioner No.1 in this case is a lady and the dispute relates to property. In case the Police wants to arrest her, they must give an advance notice to her.

However, no coercive steps including arrest be taken against the petitioners for a period of two weeks from today.
