O R D E R

This Court, on 18.3.2016 passed the following order arising out of the same impugned order:-

"Delay condoned.

The learned counsel appearing for the parties have submitted that there are certain apparent mistakes in the impugned judgment. For instance, it has been submitted that distance cannot be measured in acre, and yet the High Court has used the said unit for determining distance of the lands in question from a high way. The said submission appears to be correct. Similarly, it has been submitted that no compensation is determined in respect of the land which abuts G.T. Road.

In view of the afore-stated facts and submissions made before us, we are of the view that the petitioners should approach the High Court by filing Review Applications.

In the circumstances, permission is sought for withdrawal of the petitions. Permission is granted. The special leave petitions are accordingly disposed of as withdrawn so as to enable the petitioners to file Review Applications before the High Court.

We are sure that the High Court will consider the submissions, which might be made by the learned counsel for the petitioners on merits and in accordance with law on the basis of the material on record, after considering all submissions."

In view of the order above, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of on the aforestated terms.
