



4. However, we consider it appropriate in the interests of justice and in view of this Court's order dated 09.03.2017 passed in T.P. (C) No. 1912 of 2014, titled as "Krishna Veni Nagam vs. Harish Nagam" to direct that the trial shall be conducted and facilitated by the District Court, Indore through Video conferencing.

5. We further direct that caution and care shall be taken by the District Judge, Indore, to ensure that the witnesses be examined in a place where there is no possibility of outside influence being exerted on them, in case a separate room for conducting video conferencing is not available.

6. With the aforesaid directions, this transfer petition stands disposed of.
