Heard the learned Solicitor General appearing for the Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation.

We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High Court.

At this stage, learned Solicitor General submitted that the High Court in the impugned order has made certain adverse observations on the Policy concerned without any reasoning

The Petitioner is further granted liberty to approach this Court again, in case any adverse order is passed by the High Court.
