

liberty granted by the learned Single Judge ought not to have been deleted or set aside by the Division Bench.

Be that as it may, since the findings have been recorded in favour of the petitioners by the learned Single Judge as well as the Division Bench and relief has already been granted in favour of the petitioners herein, we are not inclined to interfere with the order passed by the High Court. However, in case any fresh complaint is filed by the writ petitioner - Ashraf Khan (respondent No.10 herein), the same may be dealt with in accordance with law and suitable remedy may be availed by the petitioners in accordance with law.

With the aforesaid observations, the special leave petition is disposed of accordingly.
