



(iv) the Trial Court will refer the dispute to the mediation after framing of issues, if not framed. The mediator will endeavor to resolve the dispute within two months from said reference, if possible.

(iv) If the dispute is not resolved in mediation, then the Trial Court shall forth proceed with the suit, conclude the proceedings and pronounce the judgment within a period of six months from that date.

4. The appeal accordingly stands disposed of.
