The petitioner has filed Writ Petition No.

3957/2018 in the High Court of Judicature At Bombay at Nagpur challenging the Order passed by the School Tribunal by which Respondent No.1 was directed to be reinstated with back wages from 31.08.2004 to 02.09.2008.

By an Order dated 05.08.2019, the direction for payment of back wages was stayed during the pendency of the writ petition, subject to the petitioner reinstating Respondent No.1 by 03.09.2019.

Aggrieved thereby, the petitioner has filed this special leave petition in which notice was issued on 23.09.2019. The writ petition is pending consideration before the High Court.

The High Court is requested to expedite the hearing of the writ petition. In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to reinstate Respondent No.1 in service, within a period of two weeks from today.
