O R D E R

We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High court. The special leave petition is accordingly dismissed.

We however, would not like to rest the matter at that since we find that on the issue of admission of secondary evidence, the revision petition

remained pending with the High Court for 11 years when the trial was stayed. We would request the Chief Justice of the High Court to look into this issue whether there may be similar other matters where trial is stayed in criminal cases on account of interlocutory proceedings.

We also consider appropriate in the present case to direct the trial Court to take the proceedings on a day to day basis as early as feasible to ensure that the trial is completed at the earliest, considering the time period which has already elapsed.

Pending application stands disposed of.
