UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

Mr. Rakesh Khanna, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, submits that the petitioner is ready to tender her resignation that too without any further claim against the respondent or any of the official of the respondent. If such a

resignation is tendered, it may be accepted.

Mr. Gaurav Sharma, learned counsel appearing for the respondent-Medical Council of India (MCI), submits that the MCI would accept the resignation, if tendered by the petitioner within four weeks from today.

Accepting the said submissions by learned counsel for the parties, we direct the petitioner to tender the resignation within two weeks from today and the same shall be accepted by the MCI. We make it clear that the appellant will not have any claim against the respondent or the officials of respondent.

The order of termination passed by the MCI shall be substituted by our order of acceptance of resignation. The original Application (OA) and all litigations against the respondent or any official of the respondent shall be withdrawn by the petitioner.

Dues, if any, of the petitioner which she is legally entitled to, shall be cleared by the MCI within four weeks from the date of acceptance of resignation.

Special leave petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
