We have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the impugned judgment and order passed by the High Court of Madhya Pradesh, Bench at Gwalior declining to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner herein.

We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High Court.

However, if the petitioner surrenders before the concerned court within two weeks from today and applies for grant of regular bail, the trial Court shall decide the same on merits, as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law.

The petitioner shall not be arrested for a period of two weeks.
