These matters relate to the development of a slum in Mumbai. The petitioner before this Court is the registered society of slum dwellers whose members were allottees of flats under the Rehabilitation Scheme.

All the same, a statement has been made on behalf of learned counsel for the intervener and learned counsel for the parties that during the pendency of the petition, the matters have now become infructuous as not only the construction has been completed but the members of the petitioner society have also been allotted flats.
