ORDER

1. Despite service of notice none has appeared on behalf of the respondents. We have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. The petitioner seeks transfer of Criminal Complaint bearing IRCT No.1010/2017 from the Court of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rewa, Madhya Pradesh to the Court of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nagpur, Maharashtra.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that between the parties (i.e. husband and wife) there are three proceedings presently pending in the competent court(s) at Nagpur including the divorce petition filed by the respondent husband initially in Rewa (M.P.) which by order of this Court dated 30th August, 2016 has been transferred to the Court of Family Judge, Nagpur, Maharashtra. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in the divorce

petition the allegations that have been levelled also centres round what has been alleged in the Complaint Complaint.

4. Having regard to the above and in view of the fact that the respondent has not appeared to oppose the prayer for transfer we allow this transfer petition. Therefore, Criminal Complaint bearing IRCT No.1010/2017, titled as "Abhinav Singh vs. Shilpa Singh" pending in the Court of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rewa, Madhya Pradesh is ordered to be transferred to the Court of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nagpur, Maharashtra. The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rewa, Madhya Pradesh shall send the case record to the transferee Court promptly and without any delay.

5. The transfer petition is accordingly allowed.
