A W A R D

1. The dispute between the parties has been referred for determination to the Lok Adalat.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the appellant, upon instructions, has stated that the appellant is ready and willing to pay an amount of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only) as a lump sum amount to the

widow of the deceased respondent within six weeks from today. Upon such amount being paid, the appellant would be entitled to withdraw the amount of Rs. 5,10,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh Ten Thousand Only) along with accrued interest lying in deposit with District Consumer Disputes Redressal Forum, Qutub Institutional Area, Delhi (DCDRF). The DCDRF will release the amount in favour of the appellant - IndusInd Bank Limited which has replaced M/s Ashok Leyland Finance Limited.

3. The matter thus stands resolved and is closed. The appellant shall pay the said amount within six weeks from today as directed above, failing which there would be an interest liability of 12% to be saddled on the above amount. The bank account of deceased's widow be provided to appellant's counsel so that the amount can be deposited in time. The amount lying in deposit with DCDRF be released only after payment is made to the widow of the respondent.

4. Court fee be refunded as per Rules.

1. The dispute between the parties has been referred for determination to the Lok Adalat.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the appellant, upon instructions, has stated that the appellant is ready and willing to pay an amount of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only) as a lump sum amount to the

widow of the deceased respondent within six weeks from today. Upon such amount being paid, the appellant would be entitled to withdraw the amount of Rs. 5,10,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh Ten Thousand Only) along with accrued interest lying in deposit with Delhi State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission(DCDRC), New Delhi (Udyog Sadan). The DCDRC, New Delhi will release the amount in favour of the appellant - IndusInd Bank Limited which has replaced M/s Ashok Leyland Finance Limited.

3. The matter thus stands resolved and is closed. The appellant shall pay the said amount within six weeks from today as directed above, failing which there would be an interest liability of 12% to be saddled on the above amount. The bank account of deceased's widow be provided to appellant's counsel so that the amount can be deposited in time. The amount lying in deposit with DCDRC be released only after payment is made to the widow of the respondent.

4. Court fee be refunded as per Rules.
