

has already undergone over 14 years sentence period and there is nothing on record to indicate that the conduct of the appellant in jail has been questionable, the prayer for bail deserves to be allowed.

Accordingly, taking overall view of the matter, we direct that, during the pendency of the appeal, the appellant be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court in connection with Sessions Case No. [162/2007] 103 of 2007 and on such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Trial Court.

The pendency of this appeal will not come in the way of the appellant to apply for premature release, if the applicable rules so permit. That proposal be considered expeditiously.
