Leave granted.

In view of order dated 11th September, 2015 passed in Civil Appeal Nos.7070-7071 of 2015, these appeals are also disposed of by directing that 50% of the enhanced compensation granted to the appellants shall be released without security whereas balance of 50% shall be released to them on furnishing security to the satisfaction of the collector. Let the State to deposit the awarded amount in question within three months to enable the parties to ensure compliance of this order. Needless to say deposit/withdrawal shall be subject to final adjudication in these appeals.

The orders of the High Court are set aside and the appeals are allowed.
