ORDER

1. Having gone through the transfer petitions filed by the petitioner-husband seeking transfer of a petition for dissolution of marriage filed by the respondent-wife under Sections 13(1)(ia) and iii of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 bearing H.M.A. Petition No. 1126 of 2019, titled "Shalini Singh Vs. Sanjay Singh" and also a petition filed by the petitioner-husband under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing H.M.A. No. 434 of 2019, titled "Sanjay Singh vs. Shalini Singh" both pending before the Principal Judge, Family Court (West), Tis Hazari Court, Delhi to the Principal Judge, Family Court, Patna, Bihar, we are not inclined to entertain the present petitions.
2. However, taking into account the fact that the petitioner-husband is suffering from paralysis and is bedridden, it is deemed appropriate to permit the petitioner-husband to appear virtually before the Family Court at Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi. Witnesses

produced by the petitioner, if not in a position to travel to Delhi and a request is made for recording the evidence through a Court Commissioner, the Family Court shall consider the same and pass appropriate orders.

3. The transfer petitions are disposed of on the above terms.
4. Pending applications are disposed of.
