O R D E R

1. We have heard Mr. K. Sharat Kumar, learned counsel appearing for the respondent-husband, who has raised objection for transfer.

2. Mr. Naveen Kumar Raheja, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner-wife, has drawn our attention to the discharge summary sheet issued by the Deen Dayal Upadhyay Hospital dated 8th November, 2014 in which it is stated that the petitioner is having backpain and is having difficulty in travelling.

3. In view of above and having regard to the ground on which transfer has been prayed for, FCOP NO.1745 of 2015 titled "Mr. Rahul Singh v. Mrs. Sneha Singh" pending before the Court of XV Additional District Judge-cum-XV Metropolitan Session Judge-cum-II Addl. Family Judge, Kukatpally at Miyapur, Ranga Reddy District, Hyderabad, Telangana, is ordered to be transferred to the Family Court at Saket, New Delhi, for hearing and disposal in accordance with law. Records shall be sent by Court where proceedings are pending to the transferee Court promptly and without any delay.

4. The transfer petition is, accordingly, allowed.

5. On receipt of the case records, the transferee Court is directed to make all endeavour for amicable settlement, failing which for early decision in the case without unnecessary adjournments.
