ORDER

1. We have heard the learned counsels for the parties.

2. Leave granted.

3. We have considered the statements made in the counter affidavit filed on behalf of the State of Rajasthan.

4. Taking into account the totality of the facts of the case we are of the view that the present appeal should be disposed of in terms of the interim order of this Court dated 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2016. We order accordingly. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest of the appellant in connection with F.I.R. No.89 of 2015 dated 21<sup>st</sup> March, 2015 registered at P.S. Kotkasim, District Alwar (Rajasthan), she shall be released on bail to

the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. The accused appellant shall cooperate with the investigation at all further stages as may be required and will make herself available for interrogation and appear before the Investigating Officer whenever such appearance is required. In the event there is any failure on the part of the appellant to so cooperate, it will be open for the prosecution to seek cancellation of the anticipatory bail granted by the present order. We also make it clear that it will be open to the Investigating Officer to impose such condition(s) as may be considered fit and appropriate.

5. Consequently, the order of the High Court is set aside and the present appeal is disposed of in the above terms.
