We are not inclined to interfere in the petitions because of the delay involved. The special leave petitions are, accordingly, dismissed.

However, even if we accept the findings of the Court below, all that is proved is that the

trees were not planted by the Forest Department and may have been planted by the petitioners. The question whether the land in which the trees were planted is forest land or not has not been decided.

Therefore, no permission shall be granted for felling of these trees except in accordance with law.
