O R D E R

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. We find that learned counsel for the respondents has not fully prepared on facts especially in view of the law laid down in "Reliance General Insurance Company Ltd. vs. Shashi Sharma &

Ors." [2016 (9) SCC 627].

3. Accordingly, the matter be listed on 13.08.2025.

4. On that day, learned counsel for the petitioner is also required to file a fresh chart in tune with the judgments in "National Insurance Company Ltd. vs. Pranay Sethi & Ors." [2017 (16) SCC 680] as also, "Sarla Verma & Ors. vs. Delhi Transport Corporation & Anr." [2009 (6) SCC 121], with regard to the heads under which according to her the claim would be maintainable and also the heads on which it will not be maintainable.

5. I.A.No.45329/2021 has been filed for substitution. But, in view of the stand taken by the learned counsel for the petitioner that respondent no.4, who has died leaving behind respondent no.1, let the name of respondent no.4 be deleted from the array of parties at the risk of the petitioner. Accordingly, I.A.No.45329/2021 is disposed of. In view thereof, no further orders are required in I.A.No.61576/2021 (application for condonation of delay in filing the setting aside the abatement) & I.A.No.61575/2021 (application for setting aside the abatement) and the same are disposed of as such.

6. After the order was dictated, learned counsel for respondents no.1, 2, 3, 5 & 6, informed that now respondent no.5 has also passed away.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even respondent no.5 is already represented by the remaining respondents in the present petition. Let respondent no.5 be

also deleted from the array of parties at the risk of the petitioner.

8. Let amended memo of parties be filed within a week by the learned counsel for the petitioners.
