Leave granted.

In the course of hearing, a suggestion was given to Ms. Aruna Mehta, learned counsel appearing for the appellant whether the enhancement of the amount by Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees two lacs fifty thousand only) will satisfy the claim put forth in the appeal. Learned counsel accepted the same. Mr. Sanjay Kumar Dubey, learned counsel appearing for the respondent-insurer, left it to the discretion of the Court.

In view of the aforesaid, the amount awarded is enhanced by Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees two lacs fifty thousand only) with the stipulation that the same shall be deposited within eight weeks hence, before the Tribunal, failing which it shall carry interest at the rate of 9% per annum

from the date of application before the Tribunal. The amount deposited shall be disbursed in favour of the appellant on proper identification.

With the aforesaid modification in the award passed by the tribunal, which has been further modified by the High Court, the appeal stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
