UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

The petitioner is named as co-accused in FIR alleged to be committed offence under Section 20(b)(ii)(c) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. The allegations against her is that she is the owner of the vehicle in which a quantity of 50.400kg.of ganja was seized.

Her application for anticipatory bail was declined by the

High Court.

This Court had initially granted her interim protection from arrest by order of this Court dated 11.02.2020.

Today, learned counsel for the State submits that the main accused is absconded. No counter affidavit has been filed. It has been brought to the notice of the Court also that the petitioner has not misused the liberty granted to her. In these circumstances, the interim bail granted to her is hereby confirmed. The petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail subject to such terms as the Trial Court may deem fit in the circumstances.

The Special Leave Petition is allowed.
