O R D E R

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the  
petitioners.

After completing 23 years of service, the respondent  
has superannuated and the present age of the respondent  
is about 80 years. The only question involved in this

petition is whether service of about 2 years and 5 months rendered by the respondent on ad-hoc basis can be considered for grant of selection scale under the Career Advancement Scheme. Based on certain decisions, the High Court has accepted the plea of the respondent and has directed the petitioners to consider the said period.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that an important question of law is involved and therefore, the same needs decision at the hands of this Court.

Considering the peculiar facts of the case which we have stated earlier, we find that this is not a fit case to interfere under Article 136 of the Constitution of India. The Special Leave Petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, we make it clear that questions of law urged by the petitioners are kept open which can be considered in an appropriate case.

Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
