Heard Mr. Krishnan Venugopal, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner in Contempt Petition (Civil) No. 1673/2017 and Mr. Amit Pawan, learned counsel for the applicants in M.A. No. 1788/2017.

A Power of Attorney has been executed in favour of the applicants in M.A. No. 1788/2017 in respect of 0.41 acres mentioned in the communication dated 27.1.2018 annexed as Annexure A-9 to the contempt petition aforementioned. The same shall be transferred by executing a sale deed. Learned counsel for the applicants in M.A. No. 1788/2017 has handed over stamp papers to Ms. Pooja Dhar, learned counsel assisting Mr. Krishnan Venugopal, learned senior counsel for the petitioner in the contempt petition. The sale deed be executed on the stamp papers within three weeks hence. If any further payment is demanded by the Registering authority for the stamp papers, the same shall be paid by the

purchasers.

The property shall be sold in favour of the applicant - Asha Singh or her associates, which has already been given by way of the Power of Attorney. In case the sale deed is not executed within the time stipulated, the applicants in M.A. No. 1788/2017 are granted liberty to file a fresh contempt petition.

Needless to say, we are closing the contempt petition on the solemn assurance given by the applicants in M.A. No. 1788/2017 that the sale deed will be executed in respect of the properties covered under the Power of Attorney.

The Contempt Petition and the Miscellaneous Application are disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
