UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

Having heard learned counsel appearing for the parties and upon perusal of the record, we find that all the similarly situated employees/accused in the transactions in question have been granted bail.

Ms. Vibha Datta Makhija, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the respondent, submits that the petitioner-accused is not a bank employee but is an employee of M/s International Electron Devices

Ltd.

We find that the High Court and the trial court have also granted bail to those accused who are employees of the aforesaid company.

Having regard to the fact that the charge-sheet has been filed and the petitioner-accused has been in custody since 22.01.2016, we see no reason as to why the petitioner should remain in custody.

We accordingly, direct the release of the petitioner on bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial court.

The petitioner shall not attempt to tamper with any evidence or contact with any witnesses. He shall not leave the District of Ghaziabad, U.P., without prior permission of the trial court.

In view of the above, the instant special leave petition is disposed of.

Pending interlocutory applications, if any, stand disposed of.
