ORDER

This transfer petition has been filed by the petitioner – wife for transfer of Matrimonial Suit No 105 of 2017 titled “Anubhav Choudhary Vs Dr. Neha Jain” from the Court of the Principal Judge, Family Court, Munger, Bihar to the Family Court at Jaipur, Rajasthan.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of this case, particularly the fact that the petitioner has a child of two years and, being a resident of Jaipur, Rajasthan, she would be put to considerable inconvenience in prosecuting the matter at Munger, Bihar, we think it appropriate to transfer the aforesaid case from the Court of the Principal Judge, Family Court, Munger, Bihar to the Family Court at Jaipur, Rajasthan.

Accordingly, the transfer petition is allowed.

The transferor court shall forthwith transmit the record of the aforesaid case to the transferee court.

Learned counsel appearing for the contesting parties state that the parties shall explore the possibility of an amicable resolution of the matrimonial dispute by appearing before the Mediation Centre attached to the Family Court at Kolkata on the date to be fixed by the Family Court.
