O R D E R

The Special Leave Petitions Nos.4858-4859 of 2018 and 20022 of 2019 were disposed of by this Court vide its judgment and order dated 12.12.2019 by issuing certain directions. However, by present application (M.A. Nos.571-572 of 2020), some apprehension is expressed by the petitioner-wife and it is prayed that appropriate

direction be issued to the respondent-husband to file an affidavit before this Court stating that no case of child abduction would be initiated or pursued by him before any of the authorities in United States of America.

Mr. Anil Malhotra, learned Advocate appearing for the respondent-husband, placed on record a copy of the letter dated 05.02.2020 issued by the Office of Children's Issues, United States Department of State, Washington, D.C. The same is accepted and taken as part of the record. On instructions, he submits that the respondent-husband has neither initiated any proceeding upto now nor does he have any intention to initiate or pursue any proceeding hereinafter. The statement is recorded.

In view of the aforesaid statement, the apprehension expressed by the petitioner-wife stands completely addressed and no further orders are called for in this Miscellaneous Application.

The parties shall do well to comply with the directions issued by this Court in letter and spirit and the petitioner-wife shall accompany the respondent-husband to United States of America and they shall effectuate all the directions issued by this Court while disposing of the Special Leave Petitions.

The Miscellaneous Application stands disposed of in aforesaid terms.
