O R D E R

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties and perused the impugned judgment and order dated 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2017 passed by the High Court of Madhya Pradesh dismissing the application for suspension of sentence.

Even though the petitioner has been convicted under Sections 420, 467 and 468 of the I.P.C and sentenced to rigorous imprisonment for five years with fine of

Rs.5,000/-, rigorous imprisonment for ten years with fine of Rs.10,000/- and rigorous imprisonment for five years with fine of Rs.5,000/- respectively with default stipulation, he has already undergone more than three years in imprisonment.

We, therefore, direct that the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing adequate security to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

The special leave petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
