This petition has been filed by the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of Marriage Petition No.1063 of 2019, titled "*Sh. K. Ram Sudhir vs. Smt. Srividya Venturupalli*", pending before the court of Principal Judge, Additional Family Court, Gurugram, Haryana, to the Family Court Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh.

The proceeding, the transfer of which is sought for, is an application under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. The respondent-husband is the petitioner in that proceeding.

At the time of hearing, Mr. Nikhilesh Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-husband submits that he has instructions to apprise this Court that the

respondent-husband shall not prosecute the Marriage Petition No.1063 of 2019 and he shall withdraw the same from the court of Principal Judge, Additional Family Court, Gurugram, Haryana.
